Directions

From Montreal's Pierre Elliott Trudeau International Airport (YUL) – 4.5 miles:

- 1) Head West (ouest) on **blvd. Roméo Vachon North (nord)**.
- 2) Slight Right on to **blvd. Roméo Vachon South (sud)**.
- 3) Take the ramp onto **Autoroute Côte-de-Liesse/Autoroute 520 West (ouest)**.
- 4) At the roundabout, take the **1st** exit onto the **Autoroute 20 West (ouest)** ramp to **Autoroute 20 West Ouest/Dorion**.
- 5) Keep left at the fork, follow signs for **Autoroute 20 Ouest/Dorion** and merge onto **Autoroute 20 Ouest/West**.
- 6) Take exit **53** for **Boulevard des Sources North (nord)**.
- 7) Merge onto **Boulevard des Sources**.
- 8) Turn left onto **Avenue Avro**. Destination will be on your Right.

From Highway 20

- 1) From Highway 20 take exit **Sources North (nord)**.
- 2) Turn left on **Avenue Avro**.

From Highway 40

- 1) From Highway 40 take exit **Sources South (sud)**.
- 2) Turn right on **Avenue Avro**.

Local Restaurants

- [St. Viateur Bagel](#) – 263 St.-Viateur Ouest (bagels - go at 3:00 a.m. on a weekend and you may have to wait in line. A Montreal must.
- [Schwartz's](#) – 3895 Saint-Laurent Blvd. (smoked meat). A Montreal must.
- [La Banquise](#) – 994 rue Rachel Est. (poutine which is french fries, gravy, and cheese and then variations on that). Another Montreal must.
- [Gibby's](#) – in Old Montreal at 298 Place d'Youville or in St. Sauveur which is up North in the Laurentian mountains at 414 Principale St. if you're interested in taking a drive. Great steaks, seafood, etc. Try the Gibby's salad – the dressing is really good.
- [The Keg](#) – in Old Montreal at 25, rue Saint-Paul Est. Great value for your money and in a terrific location
- [Decarie Hot Dog](#) – 953 boul. Decarie, in Saint-Laurent. An argument could be made for the best hot dog (steamy) in Montreal. A hole-in-the-wall that has been around for about 40 years opened by Nick the Greek. Great fries to. Poutine is gluten-free. Steamies are another Montreal must.
- [Smoke Meat Pete](#) – 283, 1st ave. in Ile Perrot. You have to love a place whose slogan is “Can't Beat Pete's Meat”. Smoked meat and blues music at night (check the site for schedule)
- [Sucrerie de la Montagne](#) – the province of Quebec is the largest producer of maple syrup in the world. Annually during the collection of sap in the spring, many locals head to their favorite sugar shack. This is ours and it happens to be open year round
